Practice time outside of class time? Is there a recommend practice time?

Practice time is seen as an investment in the progression of your participant. Practice time is done on an individual bases outside of class time without coach supervision. The purpose of this investment is not only to get better with golf but prepares them for national, regional and local student opportunities. Our goal is to put all participants in a position to be able to take advantage of what First Tee – Augusta has to offer, however, to make that happen we will need the participants and the parent's commitment.
