# What will my participant <u>NEED BEFORE FIRST DAY</u> of class?

- Appropriate size golf bag with a stand
- Appropriate size Golf Clubs \*
- Golf Tees \*
- 3 Golf Balls \*
- Golf Glove \*
- Golf shoes or sneakers
- Sharpie

## Can parents spectate during class time?

Yes, parents can observe but are asked not to interact with participants during class time.

#### Is Parent Orientation Mandatory?

Yes, here is what you can expect to be discussed:

- Dress Code
- Class Expectations
- Member Privileges
- Practice (outside of class time)
- Labeling Golf Clubs/Golf Bag
- Student Opportunities

## Should participants practice outside of class time?

Practice time is seen as an investment in the progression of your participant. Practice time is done on an individual bases outside of class time without coach supervision. The purpose of this investment is not only to get better with golf but prepares them for national, regional and local student opportunities. Our goal is to put all participants in a position to be able to take advantage of what First Tee – Augusta has to offer. It is recommended that participants commit to practicing on the range and play the golf course ~3 days a week like most other youth sports. Independent practice and course play is as valuable as supervised practice and play.

#### When will students receive their membership cards?

No Annual Fee will be charged in 2023. This year, students will receive temporary membership cards on the first day of class. Permanent membership cards will be issued upon the successful completion of the class, not exceeding two absences.
