Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

What will my participant **NEED BEFORE FIRST DAY** of class?

- Sharpie

Can parents spectate during class time/tournament ?

Yes, parents can observe but are asked not to interact with participants during class time. See Parent Spectator guidelines.

Is Parent Orientation Mandatory?

Yes, Parent Orientation is held on the 1st day of each class.

When will students receive their membership cards?

Students will receive temporary membership cards on the first day of class. Permanent membership cards will be issued upon the successful completion of the class, **not exceeding two absences**.

- Keep Own/Partner Score
- Read Yardages
- Bag Placement
- Ball Marker Placement
- Rack Bunkers

Which class should I register my child?

Certifying Session – Beginner Participate or returning participant who needs more life and golf skill development.

Tournament Play – Participants who have completed certifying class requirement. Independently carry bag and keep score, knowledgeable in course management.

Player Development – Focused supervised drills to identify areas for golf skill improvement.
