Can parents spectate during class time/tournament?

Yes, parents can observe but are asked not to interact with participants during class time. See Parent Spectator guidelines.

Is there a Parent Orientation Mandatory?

Yes, Parent Orientation is held on the 1st day of each class.

When will students receive their membership cards?

Students will receive temporary membership cards on the first day of class. Permanent membership cards will be issued upon the successful completion of the class, not exceeding two absences.

Which class should I register my child?

Certifying Session – New or returning participants doing life and golf skill development.
